Ewhurst Primary Consultation Update

The consultation for the expansion of the school from September 2026 has now closed and we enter the next phase in which Statutory Notices have been given regarding the proposal. Members of the public have the opportunity to leave feedback about the proposal until the 5th November. Thank you to those of you who have already given their views on the proposal.
